Abortion Action Missouri is recruiting Field Fellows to support our advocacy and electoral work in the Kansas City region to identify and recruit volunteers to educate voters on the upcoming abortion ban that is on the ballot in Missouri. The internship will run from as early as June 29, 2026 through November 12, 2026 and there are up to two (2) spots available.

The ideal candidates will have a passion for connecting with voters, as well as recruiting and developing leaders who want to join the movement to create change within their communities. Members of the team will play a critical role in identifying, recruiting and supporting volunteers who will support various efforts to protect reproductive freedom in Missouri. They will also partake in extensive outreach with voters to educate them on steps they can take to advance abortion access and reproductive freedom in Missouri through organizing and the political process.

Who We Are

Abortion Action Missouri is dedicated to building and sustaining a constituency that uses the political process to guarantee reproductive health, rights, and justice for every Missourian. Our mission is to foster and sustain a Midwest movement for control of our bodies, lives, and futures. We envision a world with stigma-free abortion access and reproductive freedom for all. With 60,000+ members, we are the largest statewide organization working exclusively on reproductive rights issues. Abortion Action Missouri is a grassroots 501(c)(4) advocacy organization. Two additional affiliated organizations help advance Abortion Action Missouri's mission. The Abortion Action Missouri Foundation (a 501(c)(3)) conducts public education and research intended to increase public awareness of relevant reproductive health, rights, and justice issues. The Abortion Action Missouri PAC (AAM PAC) is the political action committee that conducts direct electoral work with and for pro-choice candidates.

What You'll Learn

- General knowledge about abortion and reproductive rights, and the reproductive justice framework.
- How political power operates in Missouri and how that informs issues related to abortion access and reproductive freedom
- Core organizing tactics including traditional canvassing, volunteer recruitment, phone banking, and leadership development

What You'll Do

All Fellows will report to the Deputy Director of Organizing and Campaigns, Cara Hile. They will be responsible for the following tasks, and organizing training will be provided to support their success.

- Engage in regular door to door canvassing to engage voters or potential voters on elections and their views on abortion access and reproductive freedom
- Participate in weekly phonebanks to mobilize voters and volunteers to take action including—but not limited to—voter outreach (mega volunteer canvassing and/or phone banking) and attending Abortion Action Missouri events
- Identifying and developing volunteers into leaders who can take significant ownership over campaign goals and objectives
- Support volunteer calls, trainings, and meetings
- Building strong relationships with voters/volunteers through 1-on-1 conversations, in person when possible
- Support the recruitment, training and management of volunteer voter engagement
- Knock doors and speak with voters about the current state of abortion access in Missouri, inform them about abortion and reproductive freedom related policies, and move them to take action to advance AAM's policy agenda.
- Attend weekly check-in/debrief meetings

Must-Haves

- Reliable transportation is a necessity, with the ability to walk for long periods of time, breaks are provided every 1.5 hours and as needed.
- This position will also require utilizing Google Drive, Slack, EveryAction, and VAN. We will provide support and training to utilize these tools as needed.
- Weekend and evening work will be required.

To be successful in this job, you will excel in four areas:

- **Passion for people:** You love talking to people and learning their stories with curiosity and compassion. You develop strong relationships with voters, volunteers and leaders through a deep understanding of their stories and self-interest.
- **Learning and self-reflection:** Becoming an effective organizer is a lifelong process. As an organization, we want to foster an environment where every staff member is able to grow their skills, power, and leadership. As a Field Fellow with Abortion Action Missouri you will be asked to grow, learn new skills, and support others in their own growth. We take reflection and debrief seriously and will ask you to reflect on your achievements and growth edges, and then incorporate learning into your work.
- **Proactive problem solving:** Organizing is reorganizing. When confronted with unexpected setbacks or challenges, you will need to figure out how to pivot, problem solve, seek support where needed, and take proactive steps to address set-backs.
- **Drive:** You are serious about building people power and can address issues with the utmost urgency when the moment calls.

If you were here right now, you would be:

- Knocking doors and talking to voters about the upcoming abortion ban that will be on the ballot
- Making calls and reaching out to previously contacted voters to sign up for volunteer mega canvassing shifts.
- Having 1-on-1 conversations with voters to engage them in volunteer canvassing and organizational opportunities aligned with their self-interest.
